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Norwegian's Traffic Figures April 2010

Norwegian's passenger traffic, production and number of passengers in April were heavily disrupted by the closure of European airspace due to volcanic ash.

The total number of passengers flown in April 2010 was 791,371 compared to 861,530 last year, a decrease of 70,159 passengers (-8 %).

Compared to the same period last year:

- Total passenger traffic (RPK) increased by 1 %
- Total capacity (ASK) increased by 13 %
- The load factor was 71 %, down 8 p.p.
