## Norwegian's traffic figures April 2011

The total number of passengers flown in April 2011 was 1,207,891 compared to 791,371 last year, an increase of 416,520 passengers (53 %).

Compared to the same period last year:

- Total passenger traffic (RPK) increased by 58 %
- Total capacity (ASK) increased by 44 %
- The load factor was 77 %, up 6 p.p.
